

# FUN Literacy Activities you can do at home!

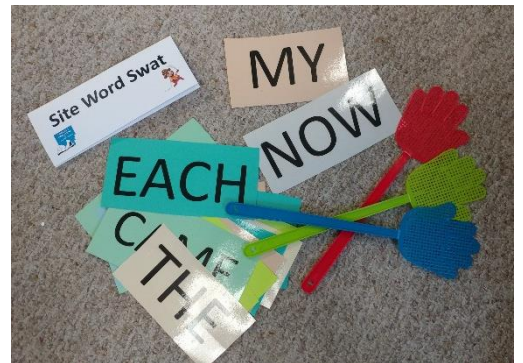
Use this guide to help you create some fun literacy activities at home!  
Grades PreK-2<sup>nd</sup> (but can be modified for any age!)

## Sight Word Swat

Materials: Sight words written on paper  
Fly swatters

Activity:

1. Spread several sight words out on the floor
2. Parent - pick a sight word and say it out loud
3. The child finds that word and swats it
4. Repeat!

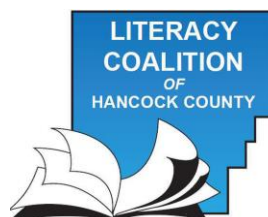


## Memory

Materials: Paper plates with words that have a match

Activity:

1. Lay the plates face down on the table (or floor if there is space)
2. Have the child turn two over at a time - reading the words, trying to match the words
3. If they do not match, both plates get turned back to face down
4. The child picks two more plates
5. They keep going until they have matched all the plates



## Read and Sort

Materials: Plastic Spoons  
Plastic Cups

### Activity:

1. Write small words on the spoons (ex: hat)
2. Write matching ending sounds on the cups (ex: "at")
3. Have a child pick up a spoon and read the word out loud
4. Then have them put the spoon in the proper cup that has the same ending sound that matches the word on the spoon
